THE GRANTEE PROVIDED THE FOUNDATION WITH REPORTS AND OTHER INFORMATION ON THE USE OF FUNDS THAT ENABLED THE FOUNDATION TO VERIFY COMPLIANCE WITH TERMS OF THE GRANT, AND THE PROGRESS MADE BY THE GRANTEE TOWARD ACHIEVING THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE GRANT WAS MADE. THE FOUNDATION BELIEVES THAT OLSF III HAS COMPLIED WITH THE TERMS OF THE GRANT, WITHOUT EXCEPTION. OLSF III IS CURRENTLY RAISING FUNDS AND IS NOT YET FULLY INVESTED. THE FOUNDATION HAS A \$1,000,000 COMMITMENT TO THE FUND, \$875,000 OF WHICH HAS BEEN CALLED AS OF DECEMBER 31, 2023.
